Cultural Heritage Fortified Monuments - a building block in the history of the DEMOCRACY MOVEMENT in Europe

The history of democracy is the history of upheaval, revolution, the struggle for freedom and self-determination, the struggle for participation and the involvement of all in political decision-making.

Fortified monuments often provided a backdrop for the democratic movement, for instance when thick walls protected Italian city *republics* in the 12th/13th century, when the fortresses of aristocrats resisted revolutions, when Napoleon spread democratic ideas from fortress to fortress with the *Code Civil*, when the heavily fortified former Rhine Confederation states became strongholds of early liberalism and when the *Hambach Festival* in the ruins of the fortified Hambach Castle in 1832 became the cradle of democracy in Germany.

The fortresses were central to the battles between revolutionary groups and the military, they were prisons for revolutionary prisoners or final retreats for entire revolutionary armies. Europe is rich in these monumental fortifications, which represent European history in its various eras.

Today, the historical fortresses, once built as military defences, are places of peace and culture for all people. As European cultural route, FORTE CULTURA tells the story of this cultural heritage and thus also the history of democracy.

The *European Fortress Summer*, organised by FORTE CULTURA for the first time in 2018 to mark the European Year of Cultural Heritage, combines events in fortresses throughout Europe under the motto: What once separated people, brings them now together. For a living cultural heritage of fortified monuments in a solidary, democratic and peaceful Europe. We are in!"

Fortresses are therefore still places of democratic history today, because they tell the important story of the democracy movement, because they are places for encounters, education and international understanding, because they once again protect people and goods in Ukraine from the attacks of dictatorial systems of power.

As a European cultural route, FORTE CULTURA wants to preserve the important cultural heritage of the fortified monuments and make it accessible to everyone.

The FORTE CULTURA Annual Congress 2024 in the EU Parliament in Strasbourg with the theme "**Cultural heritage of fortified monuments – a building block in the history of the democracy movement in Europe**" is intended to underpin these goals.

FORTE CULTURA would like to send a further signal in favour of safeguarding human rights, democracy and the rule of law. The cultural heritage of the fortified monuments is an impressive testimony to Europe's martial history, which today stands as a cultural and educational centre for the promotion of international understanding, international sentiment and tolerance.

Fortress Kaiser Wilhelm II (Fort de Mutzig) Prussian fort of superlative

254 ha, 40,000 m² underground area for 7,000 men, built in 1893-1915 as the first concreted, armoured and electrified fortress.

The fortress of Mutzig is ideally located on a hill in the Vosges mountains to control the Alsatian plain and the exit of the Breusch valley and the roads and railway lines between the Vosges and Strasbourg.

Forteresse de l'empereur Guillaume II (Fort de Mutzig) Fort prussien superlatif

254ha, 40.000 m² de surface souterraine pour 7.000 hommes d'équipage, construite entre 1893 et 1915 comme première forteresse bétonnée, blindée et électrifiée.

La forteresse de Mutzig est idéalement située sur une colline des Vosges pour contrôler la plaine d'Alsace et la sortie de la vallée de la Breusch ainsi que les routes et voies ferrées reliant les Vosges à Strasbourg.

Feste Kaiser Wilhelm II (Fort de Mutzig) Preußische Feste der Superlative

254ha, 40.000 m² unterirdische Fläche für 7.000 Mann Besatzung, erbaut 1893-1915 als erste betonierte, gepanzerte und elektrifizierte Festung

Die Feste von Mutzig liegt ideal auf einem Hügel der Vogesen, um die Elsässische Ebene und den Ausgang des Breusch-Tals und die Straßen und Eisenbahnlinien zwischen den Vogesen und Straßburg zu kontrollieren.

Fort Podbielski-Ducrot, Mundolsheim (FR) guided tour / Visite guidée / Führung ca. 90 min

Built by Prussia in 1879-1882 as the last fort of the Strasbourg belt and extended, reinforced and integrated into the Maginot Line until 1936.
